Mise en train : (Warming up)

Can you repeat the word (the sentence), please ? / Can you say it again, please ? ;
Open. ; Close... Get in two teams / Get in pairs. Whose turn is it ?
Take (out) your pen / scissors, please.
Draw a cat / an elephant / ... ; **Colour the dog brown** ; Is everything clear ? ; Have you got any questions ? ;
